Today, we have sophisticated underground bunkers to protect ourselves. A good refuge provides protection and peace for us when we're scared. That is exactly the kind of refuge that God is to us when we trust in Him and His Son, Jesus Christ. It doesn't mean we won't get scared or worry but it does mean that God will be there with us in the scary times and help us.

Part of the fun is setting up the course so let your kids help!

After you've tried it one way for a while, let the kids change it up. If you're looking to avoid the natural competition between siblings, have them run the course against their own time; working toward a "personal best". This provides a great opportunity to teach a child what happens when they work hard at something and practice (memorizing scripture, practicing the piano or soccer, multiplication tables, whatever your child is involved in).

- Use things around the house to set up the **obstacle course** in the yard.

 - Pool Noodles
 - Long 2x4 or 4x4 (makes a great balance beam)
 - Balloons
 - A Rope
 - Newspapers
- Walks, bike rides, nature walks, bear hunts
