MAIN TEXT:

Hebrews 10:19-25

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Belong: (Ice Breaker): How do you plan to celebrate Easter? Do you have any Easter traditions?

Leader's Note to Share with your group:

Today we are in part 3 of our new series called Between the Lines: We're studying the book of Hebrews as we move toward celebrating Jesus' resurrection at Easter. Hebrews helps us see Jesus clearly, which does two things for us – We love Jesus more and we grow up in our faith. A faith filled with a deeper love for Jesus and faith that has grown up is a STRONG faith.

Hebrews is like a KEY for understanding what is hard to understand about God in the Old Testament. We will look at how Jesus uniquely fulfilled all the Old Testament law, ritual, temples, priestly leadership, and the sacrificial system.

Believe:

Read: Hebrews 10:11-18

- What did the priest do constantly? Why? What barrier was he trying to overcome?
- Read Hebrews 10:4 - what light does this shed on the work of the priests before Jesus came?
- What did Christ do? Why was it different?
- What did Christ do after he made the once for all sacrifice? Why is that significant?
- What did God do as a result of the sacrifice of Jesus?

Read Hebrews 10:19-23

- What is the new invitation given to us because of Jesus? In what way are we invited to come? (Read 10:22 in more than one translation to get the most complete meaning of how we are invited to approach the throne of grace).
- Why does what we believe about Jesus matter so much? What should this belief do for us?
- What is the secret to holding onto to the hope have? How can we do that practically every day? Share a time when you held on to hope and God was faithful.

Believe:

Read: Hebrews 10:24-25

- According to this passage, why do we need each other?

Share: *“The physical presence of other Christians is a source of incomparable joy and strength to the believer.”* Dietrich Bonhoeffer

- When have other Christians been a source of joy and strength to you? What was going on in your life at the time? What did they do or say to encourage you during that time?
- Why do we sometimes “neglect” to meet together? How can we guard against that type of community drift from happening? Have you ever been away from church and then came back? What made the difference in how and when you returned?
- Who do you know that needs to be encouraged and brought into or back into the community of believers we have at First Orlando?

Become: (Closing)

- Spend time together in prayer
