Discussion Questions

Belong: Icebreaker

What was the first job you had? How did you get the job? Did you love it or hate it?
What did you learn from that job?

Believe:

Read Proverbs 6:6-11

How is the Ant contrasted with the Sluggard (or slacker)? What is the warning for us in this passage in Proverbs?

Read Ephesians 6:5-9 and Colossians 3:22-25

According to these passages, what should our rightful motivation be for the work we do?
What kind of challenges come up in your work life for this type of attitude to be consistent for you?

What do you think it means to work “heartily” for the Lord? Can you give an example of this in real life? Who is someone who has modeled this type of work for you?

What difference would that make in the way you work if you worked “for” the Lord and not for “man’s approval?”

Read Proverbs 6:8

When does the Ant labor? When does the Ant “gather” or reap the harvest? What does this teach us about the delayed gratification of work?

According to Colossians 3:24, when is the believer’s true reward?

How does working with our eternal reward in mind change the way we work? How could it benefit those we work for and with?

Become:

Go back to Proverbs 6:6-11 and read it once again.

With this passage fresh in your mind, consider the ANT, what is God saying to you about work and how do you want to respond?

Take time to share prayer requests related to the work we do. Pray together as a group and follow-up throughout the week to see how your prayers are being answered.
