BELONG Ask this Ice Breaker Question: Has there ever been a time when you have had to blend in to fit into a new group or a new job or a new church? BELIEVE Have someone in your group read aloud: 1 Corinthians 9:19-23 Ask these questions to prompt group discussion: 1. In 1 Corinthians 9 Paul is interacting with a common term - CULTURE. How do you define the word culture? And, is there a way that you normally interact with the culture around you? Leader Context (Not to be read aloud): • Culture - the customs, arts, social institutions, and achievements of a particular nation, people, or other social group. "culture" has become a buzzword in post-modern society and it is trendy for intellectual leaders to want to interact with various cultures and sub-cultures as a way to frame conversations of meaning. Your group may struggle to define this term, but will likely be more subconsciously aware of the culture around them. 2. Paul offers a peek into his ministry strategy: a. He adopts some of the cultural features b. He adapts his language to that of the larger culture c. His ultimate aim is to preach The Gospel to that culture Has there ever been a time when you have had to adopt or adapt to try to minister to the new culture around you? Were you successful in this effort? 3. A common analogy for interacting with culture says Christians should think thermostat and not thermometer when approaching Gospel ministry (A thermostat changes the temperature in the room. A thermometer adjusts to the temperature in the room). How do you think Paul would respond to this
