BELONG

Ask this Ice Breaker Question: What is the best team you have ever been a part of? Sports? Work? Volunteer organization? Other?

BELIEVE

Have someone in your group read aloud: 1 Corinthians 12:14*26

Ask these questions to prompt group discussion:

1. The NIH (National Institute of Health) has identified "team dynamics" as one of the greatest factors contributing to a positive community development in American culture. Why do you think teams, as opposed to individual leadership, are such an effective force in contributing to positive social development?

Leader Context: Answers might include the following:

- Burden sharing
- Resourcefulness
- Collaboration
- "We're better together."
- 2. Why do you think Paul encourages us to work together in the local church body? How is Paul's encouragement similar and different than what the NIH might recommend?

<u>Leader Context:</u>

- For Paul, there is an eternal component.
- Community development is a earthly value, not a heavenly one. Its temporal.
- Paul encourages us to work together not just for the building of an earthly community, but to build heaven's community as it comes to earth.
- 3. Paul instructs the Corinthians to earnestly desire the higher gifts. What do you suppose that Paul means here?

Leader Context:

- This is likely Paul's way of bringing up supernatural elements.
- Paul knows that any community can have laborers.
- Paul wants the church to make space for the uncontrolled, the supernatural, the OTHER.
- Paul wants the local church to be a community of ordinary with an expectation of extraordinary.
