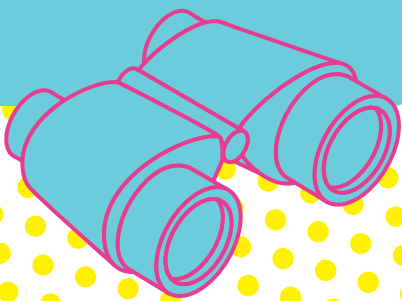
DAY 1

Focus on what
you can see!

Binoculars

SAY THIS

Binoculars help us see.
We are reminded of God
when we see the
animals, the plants,
the oceans, and people
He made!



WHAT YOU NEED:

- 2 toilet paper rolls or 1 paper towel roll cut in half per child
- Stapler, tape or glue
- 3 ft yarn per child
- Hole punch
- Markers, stickers, construction paper or paint for decorating...whatever you have around the house

WHAT YOU DO:

If you wish to cover your binoculars in construction paper, do this prior to connecting the rolls. Hand each child 2 rolls. Have them decorate the rolls with whatever materials you have around the house. When finished, connect the two rolls with either a stapler, tape or glue. (The glue will need a day to dry)
Hole punch holes into the sides of each roll.
Pull one side of the string through each hole and knot to secure.



ACTIVITY:

BOTTOM LINE:

FOCUS on what you can see.

Ask, what can you see right now that God created? When we focus on God, we get to experience Him in new ways. And when we focus on the things we see that He has made—the world and everything in it—we can learn amazing things about Him. When we see what God has made, it can help us trust God more, because we see how powerful and creative and thoughtful and kind, He is. When we see the things He has made, they point us to Him. It's important to FOCUS on what you can see.
